We also take advantage of Wednesday early release days. At least twice a week teachers meet in their Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) to collaborate on data analysis and essential standards. In addition, at least once a month on Wednesdays, teachers receive professional development on a variety of topics such as English Language Development and Socioemotional Learning.

EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Every instructional minute counts as we strive for unparalleled student achievement. Our 2018-2019 SBAC scores were

above the district average at 35.42% proficiency for math and 44.77% for English Language Arts (ELA). Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, students did not take the test for the 2019-2020 school year. Our goal continues to be to increase student proficiency for both Math and Language Arts and we will use district benchmark data for comparison and measurement. For the 20-21 school year we will have:

- Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) for staff with the focus on increasing academic achievement
- Instructional Leadership Team with the focus on Unparalleled Academic Achievement
- Monthly parent/community meetings to address concerns and answer questions.
- PBIS team that focuses on positive school wide behavioral systems such as Caught Ya's, positive office referrals and life skills award assemblies
- 1:1 computers in grades 1 6 and 3:1 for Kinder
